

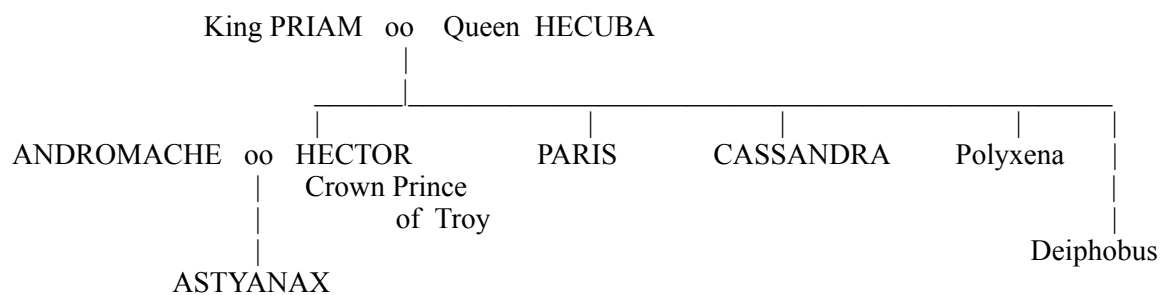

## The JUDGMENT of PARIS

PARIS, exiled Prince of Troy, is asked to judge between HERA vs APHRODITE vs ATHENA as to who is “the fairest”

The “Rape [Theft] of Helen” > HELEN — “the face that launched a thousand ships”

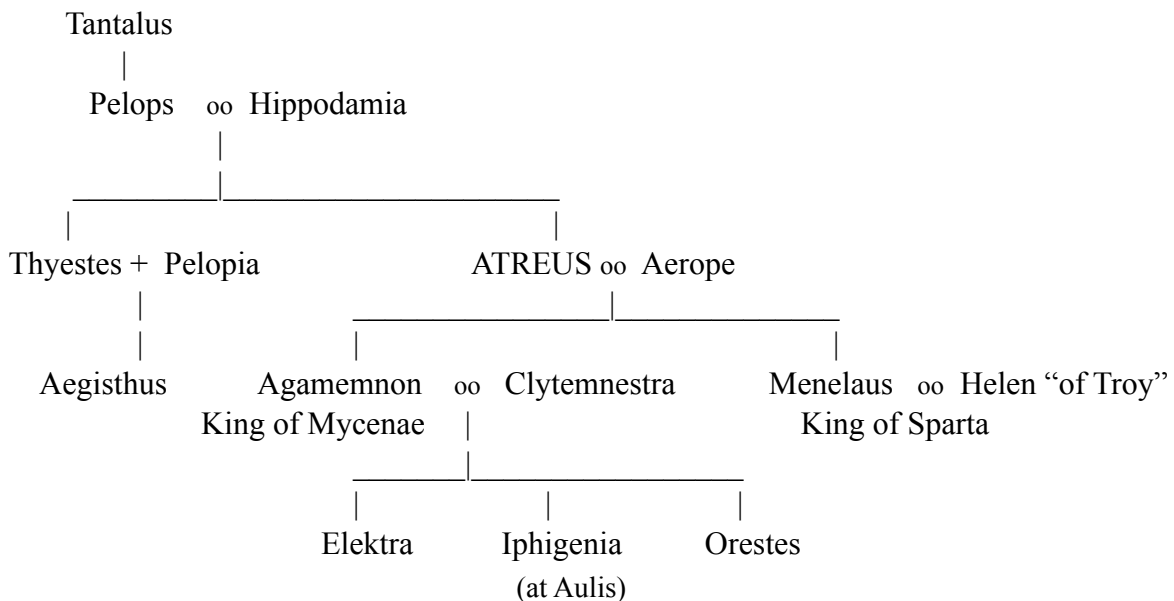
