1. Martello Tower on Dublin Bay
2. School in Dalkey, a suburb near Tower
3. Walking on strand at Sandymount, north of Dalkey

4. 7 Eccles street, north of the River Liffey
5. Walk, from Liffey south to baths near Trinity College
6. Funeral, from Sandymount, northwest through city to Prospect Cemetery, Glasnevin.
7. Newspaper office, Nelson's Pillar, north of the Liffey
8. Lunch at Davy Byrne's pub, from pillar south, past Trinity, to library
9. National Library, Kildare street, south of Trinity
10. Ensemble, mostly in the old city, southwest, Castle area
11. Bar, Ormand Hotel, on quay north of river
12. Barney Kiernan's pub, north of the Ormond hotel
13. On the beach at Sandymount strand
14. Holles street Hospital, near Marrion Square
15. Bella Cohen's brothel in the Dublin red-light district Joyce called "nighttown," just north of the Liffey and west of the Amiens Street Railway Station

16. Cab shelter near Customs House
17. Bloom's kitchen, 7 Eccles street
18. Molly in bed, and in eternity
